Arrival at camp can be anytime after 4:00 pm on Friday, September 26th, p.m. at Ponder Park (25199 76 Ave). I suggest eating dinner before arriving, unless you plan on cooking a meal/snack Friday night.

Pickup is at camp on Sunday, September 28th, 11:30 a.m.

Groups are responsible for bringing in their own gear (tents, tarps kitchen, etc...) and supplying their own food. As well, each Pack needs to bring a large bag of candy to be used in the Barnyard Scramble, and Bagherra's Game. If possible, each youth should bring a compass, and, if the individual Pack allows, a knife, to be possibly used during the knife session. Knives should be small lockblades, and kept closed at camp except for when being used in session or an appropriate time as determined by Leaders.

Each Pack will also need to bring paper, pencils, and felt pens/pencil crayons – for writing and designing the Camp Crest.

We will need matches (probably a number of boxes) for fire lighting practice.

Don't forget that each Pack is responsible for youth/Leader rartios, Medical Forms, and their own First Aid. The cost of camp is \$5 to cover the cost of camp, and perhaps any other minor costs, and is payable at camp. Cheques payable to Big Keeo (HEE HEE JUST KIDDING).
