

# JUNGLE CAMP GUIDELINES

## **CUBS/BEAVERS:**

Cub/Beaver ratio - one Cub for every five Beavers, so that each six formed will have at least one Cub to lead it.

## **LEADERS:**

Boy/Leader ratio to meet the Cub camping requirements (one adult for every six youth).

- A minimum of one Beaver Leader from **EACH COLONY** represented.
- Beaver Leaders attend in a **supporting role only**.

## **CAMP PROGRAM:**

- Introduce the White-Tails to the Tenderpad requirements as outlined in **The Cub Book**.
- Skits, games, crafts based on the Jungle theme and characters.
- Introduce the Jungle story and its characters.
- Introduce simple Jungle dances.
- Learn the Grand Howl, Cub salute and handshake.
- Hold a Scout's Own on Sunday.

## **RECOGNITION:**

- A Jungle Camp Crest (not to be worn on the uniform) that can be awarded to all participants available from Scout Shop after Area approval of the **Camping and Outdoor Activity Application**.
- It is suggested that a year flash be attached to each crest to denote the year the camp was attended.

A copy of the camp program and a **Camping and Outdoor Activity Application** MUST be forwarded 4-6 weeks before the event **even if the Jungle Camp is only a day-camp** for approval by the Area Commissioner.
