

# Nicomekl Area Kub Kar Rally 2019

## February 23, 2019

**Where:** St. Nicholas Catholic Church Gymnasium  
20675 - 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Langley

**What time:** 9:00 am - Scouters arrive to set up tracks  
9:30 am - Cub arrival and registration  
10:00 am - Design judging and races begin

**Design Categories:** Best Design Kar  
Best Hot Wheel Style Kar  
Best Wacky Kar

### Kub Kar Construction Specifications:

- Official Size
  - Overall width, including wheels shall not exceed 7 cm (2.75 inches)
  - Overall length shall not exceed 17.8 cm (7 inches)
  - Overall weight shall not exceed 142g (5 ounces)
  - Minimum distance between the wheels is 4.5 cm (1.75 inches)
  - Clearance between the chassis and the track should be 0.95 cm
  - Axles, wheels and body shall be from the materials provided in the Kub Kar Kit
- Wheel bearings, washers, bushings and springs are prohibited
- The use of liquid graphite and oils is prohibited. Dry graphite is permitted.
- Details and attachments may be added providing they are securely fastened and do not exceed the maximum length, width and weight specifications
- Kub Kars must be free-wheeling and may only be propelled by the force of gravity
- Kub Kars are subject to inspection by the Race Committee to determine eligibility. The Race Committee will ensure that all construction specifications are followed to ensure a fun and safe event for all participating Cubs and Scouters

### Race Rules:

- **All Kub Kars must be turned in no later than February 10th.** Kars will be weighed on the Official Scale and will be numbered. The Kars will be returned to the Contact Scouter on Race Day. If any major adjustments need to be made the Contact Scouter will be advised in time for adjustments to be made before the race. No late arrivals - Kars not turned in by the deadline will not be eligible to race.

- All Cubs in Nicomekl Area are eligible to enter and must be present to race (a substitute Beaver/Cub/Scout may race any Kars for Cubs that are absent but no youth may race more than one Kar on Race Day)
- Pit Crew are the only adults allowed to assist Cubs with repairs to their Kars
- Only Race Control Crew (Scouters in uniform) are allowed within the roped off Race Area
- All parents/siblings/visitors must remain behind the roped off area and away from the racetracks while the Rally is taking place. After ALL races have completed the visitors are welcome to move on to the Race Floor.
- The Official Scorer has the final decision-making authority in all race disputes
- The Race Master will determine which Kub Kar track will be used to determine the Overall Winners in each Age Category

### Reminders:

- Scouters - please remind your Cubs:
  - All Kars must be clearly marked with the Cub's Name, Pack Name and Cub Year. Each Kar will be numbered by the Race Officials and Cubs are encouraged to not remove the numbers from their Kars until the race is complete
  - Cubs will need to listen for their Kar number to be called, Cubs who choose to leave the Race Area while the event is taking place risk missing their heat. The race will not be delayed while waiting for Cubs to return from anywhere other than the Pit Crew Area
  - Racetracks can be easily damaged and people should never step over the tracks. They must always walk around the tracks to avoid any damage
  - Once ALL the races are complete the Cubs will be free to race their Kars for as long as the tracks remain in place.
  - Winners will be announced by Age Group once all race forms have been calculated. Cubs who have left the building at the time of the final races used to determine the Overall Winners will be disqualified.
  - Design Winners will be announced at the end of the Rally and all decisions of the Design Judges will be final. Cubs should be encouraged to remain until the end and to cheer for the Design Winners but do not need to be present to win (Kars entering only the Design event must be clearly marked "Design only" to avoid kars being numbered for racing and not taking part in the heats)
  - In the interest of safety - NO FOOD or DRINKS are allowed on the Gymnasium floor

**Scouters** - please plan to remain behind to assist with clean-up at the end of the event.  
Everyone will have worked hard this morning and the more hands we have to help clean up - the faster we can get it done **TOGETHER**.
