Schools and Scouting, Partners in Education is an innovative outdoor education program offered by Scouts Canada, now in its eighth year, is designed to supplement the Ministry of Education's prescribed curriculum for grades 5,6, and 7 in Capp, social studies, science, physical education, and fine arts. School Districts in Vancouver, Burnaby, Surrey, Maple Ridge-Pitt Meadows and Coquitlam have enjoyed participating in our program. Last year more than 750 students attended camp, and this year the numbers are growing.

The program is a combination of eight in-classroom sessions on topics ranging from Teambuilding, Orienteering, Fire Building, camp cooking, Pioneering, and Survival skills. ***Schools and Scouting*** content is derived from skills taught in the first-year Scout program. The program fills a niche for those teachers and parents who are still interested in these necessary skills, but may not have the personal skills or the resources to do it alone. The in-class sessions are an introduction to a variety of skills followed by a two and a half day camp in May or June. The camp program will be held at Camp Byng, Camp Mclean, or Camp Boyle.
